

## MIMS Course Handbook & Purchase of Laboratory Coats 2022-23

MIMS course handbooks are digital this year and are available on the MIMS Moodle site. The handbook will include timetables and means for the delivery of lectures, practicals and problem-based learning (PBL) sessions prior to Michaelmas term, along with other useful information. MIMS lectures will be delivered in person, as per the details in the course handbook and timetable. A link to the recording of each lecture will be available shortly after each session via the MIMS Moodle site, embedded within the individual lecture block section. There will also be link on the Moodle site to watch a live stream of the lectures.

Practicals and PBLs will be in person; schedules are available in the handbook.

### Tuesday 04 and Wednesday 05 October 2022, 10:00 – 17:00

If you have not already done so you can buy a laboratory coat (£14.00) and a range of different style safety spectacles (£4.50 - £6.00). You require a lab coat for Molecules in Medical Science (MIMS) laboratory practicals, but not for the MIMS problem-based learning exercises. You can also use it in other courses.

### Where to go to purchase your laboratory coats:

The Biochemistry Department teaching laboratory - go into the Downing Site by the archway entrance in Downing Street. Turn left and go down the main North-South axis road. Turn right after the second large building on your right (Genetics). On your left look out for the white pebble-dash 1960s Wellcome Wing of the Biochemistry Hopkins Building. There is a door at the end of the building nearest to you with a sign identifying the Department of Biochemistry. Once inside, there are steps up to the Teaching Rooms, where the Problem-Based Learning sessions occur. The steps down lead to the teaching laboratory where you do your MIMS practical laboratory work. Be prepared for a social queue.

### Collection procedure and £14.00 charge for lab coat

The price of each lab coat is £14.00 and this can be pre-paid online, using the following link:

If you are unable to pre-pay (which is the preferred option), you will have the option to pay by card at the session. All items ordered online must be collected from the Biochemistry Department teaching laboratory.

To minimize the number of students arriving, sets have been assigned hour slots in which to attend; please see the timetable for details and turn up at some point during your scheduled hour slot. If there is a queue outside, please be patient or return when it is quieter.

### First sessions

The MIMS Launch lecture is scheduled for **Thursday, 06 October 2022 at 12.00** in The Babbage Lecture Theatre. The first session of the practical course (Problem-Based
