Protective Clothing

Congratulations on joining the University of Cambridge and welcome to the veterinary course!

As part of your first year course, you will attend animal handling classes, suitable protective clothing is required for these sessions.

For large animal work, we recommend **boiler suits**. These can also be used in the clinical years and for farm EMS. You will also need **toe-protective Wellington boots** and **waterproof trousers**. For small animal work, you will need a **white lab coat**.

These items can be ordered from the Department of Veterinary Medicine, via the online sales system <https://onlinesales.admin.cam.ac.uk/product-catalogue/products/schools-faculties-departments-and-institutions/veterinary-medicine-protective-clothing-equipment>

Remember to indicate your required sizes. You will be asked to select your sizes once you reach the checkout stage of the process. If the size ordered does not fit, you can exchange it at a later date.

Items will be held at the Stores Office, Department of Veterinary Medicine, and can be collected when you arrive in Cambridge to start your course.
