

The 2020-21 MIMS course

The handbook for the 2020-21 MIMS course will be available as a digital copy on the MIMS Moodle site and will include timetables and means for the delivery of lectures, practicals and problem-based learning (PBL) sessions prior to Michaelmas term.

We are adapting the MIMS syllabus for a combination of remote and in-person learning and will be relying on Moodle as the platform for delivery. At present we cannot be specific about the structure of the course what forms of these will take and can only propose likely teaching scenarios.

The Introduction to MIMS lecture will be available on the MIMS Moodle website prior to Michaelmas term.

All lectures will be pre-recorded, online, accessible through Moodle and available throughout the academic year.

Currently we are planning for the structure for delivery of the majority of practicals and PBLs will consist of one in-person session and one remote discussion session.

The learning outcomes of the course remain unaltered.
